We look forward to seeing you this summer at Middle States Soccer Camp. This letter confirms your acceptance and provides all of the information you will need to attend the camp. REGISTRATION

All players are requested to join Middle States Soccer Camp between Noon and 2:00 pm on opening day. There will be signs at the entrance of the facility providing directions to registration. You are welcome to walk around the facilities and grounds. At 1:00 pm there will be a presentation for parents on the College Selection Process. At 2:15 pm the Camp Director will address the players and parents, introduce the staff, and outline the week's program. At the conclusion of this address, you will have the opportunity to speak personally with the Camp Director.

SUPPLIES

You should bring soccer shoes, tennis shoes, athletic gear (including shin guards), pillows, towels, bed linens (twin), light blanket, alarm clock, toilet articles, casual clothes for off the field wear, bathing suit, sun screen, and medications, if needed. A water jug and a fan are also suggested. You should also bring a bag for carrying your gear and personal items to and from the field. Please have all equipment and personal items clearly marked with your name. *Day and Extended day campers do not need to bring a fan or bed linens/pillows.*

Rooms are not locked. We recommend that additional valuables such as electronic games, CD players, jewelry, etc. be left at home. If necessary and brought to camp, valuables should be stored in a lockable container or checked in with the Administrative Director.

There is limited availability of public telephones. *It is strongly advised that campers have cell phones with them.*

NEITHER THE CAMP NOR THE INSTITUTION USED AS A SITE WILL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY.

MEDICAL CARE

If your player is required to take medication during camp, please indicate so on the medical release form and bring it along with your child's medication to camp. Medication must be in the prescription bottle from the pharmacy. For your child to take over-the-counter pain medication at camp, you must indicate so on the medical and liability release form. Players attending the camp with pre-existing injuries are required to provide their own tape, ace bandages, etc. Failure to provide this medical equipment will result in a fee being charged. Please notify the camp of any conditions requiring special medical care. **An athletic trainer will be in residence at all times.**

CAMP STORE

Open during registration and each day after training sessions. The following soccer supplies are available: shirts, shorts, socks, and shin guards. Pizza, sodas and snacks may also be purchased. You are advised NOT to carry cash. You may open a store account. Suggested amount is \$50.00. Any amount left in the campers account must be redeemed at the end of camp.

ACCOMMODATIONS

All players will be housed in the campus residence halls. There will be adult female staff supervising the girls and adult male staff supervising the boys while in the residence halls. Most rooms are two-person rooms. Every effort will be made to meet requests indicated on application. Room assignments will be given at registration.

SECURITY

All facilities have a Police/Security Staff who patrol the grounds and secure all buildings.

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT (Day and Extended Day)

At 8:45 am each day you should arrive and check in at the designated area. You are required to check out in the camp store when you leave.

Day campers must be checked out and picked up by 5:00 pm each day and Extended Day Campers must be checked out and picked up by 9:00 pm each day.

Please note that on the last day, camp begins an hour earlier at 8:00 am.

MEALS

Resident campers will be provided with three meals per day. Extended day campers will be provided with two meals per day (lunch and dinner). Day campers will be provided with one meal per day (lunch). Meals are cafeteria style and players may select and eat as much as they want.

REST PERIODS

During meal times etc., there are lounges to relax in.

DISMISSAL

The camp reserves the right to dismiss any camper for misconduct or violation of rules. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.**

CLOSING CEREMONIES

Closing ceremonies will begin at 10:30 am and campers are dismissed at 11:00 am on the final day. Parents/siblings/relatives/friends are welcome to attend. **EVERYONE IS EXPECTED TO ATTEND CLOSING CEREMONIES UNLESS PRIOR NOTICE IS GIVEN TO THE CAMP ADMINISTRATION.**

PAYMENT

To reduce delays at check-in, please pay balance within two weeks of Day of Arrival. Balance will be accepted at check-in if absolutely necessary.

No child will be allowed to participate in any part of the program unless payment has been received in full along with a signed medical and liability release form as well as a signed camp rules form.

MIDDLE STATES SOCCER CAMP REFUND/CREDIT POLICY

If Middle States Soccer Camp is notified prior to the opening day of camp, there will be a \$250.00 credit towards a session of your choice for the following season only in case of: physical injury, illness, family or personal emergency. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS ON INITIAL DEPOSIT.**

If Middle States Soccer Camp is notified after camp has begun, there will be a percentage refund of balance of payment (beyond initial deposit) only in the case of: physical injury, illness, family or personal emergency.

THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL OR DISMISSAL FOR DISCIPLINARY REASONS.

PLEASE WRITE CAMPER'S NAME ON ANY CHECKS OR CORRESPONDENCE SENT TO MIDDLE STATES SOCCER CAMP. A \$35 CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ANY CHECK RETURNED FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS. FEDERAL TAX ID # 54-13-00829
